1. Everyone rides the bus to Olympia. We encourage all students to stay and watch the entire competition and sit together for awards. If you must leave early with your parents, please bring a signed note before we leave Saturday morning. Give this note to me before the bus leaves. When leaving Olympia, please sign out on the sign clipboard which is located in the front seat of the van. You may not leave with anyone other than your parents at any time unless you have a note signed by your parents giving you permission to go home with someone else. Again, I must have this note before we leave the High school.
2. Uniform – remember black socks, no jewelry, long hair up in hats. Please make sure all pants are hemmed properly. Wear only athletic shorts and light colored t-shirts under your uniform. NO JEANS under your band pants.
3. Plumes must be returned to the plume box and put in the cardboard holder.
4. There will be a concession stand at Olympia which will be open all day. Bring your own money or your own lunch. The Music Boosters will also be providing water, Gatorade, and snacks only.
5. Loading information – you are responsible for loading your own instrument. Drumline, sousas and pit should load first. When we arrive at our destination, form a line, go through the trailer, get your instrument, then put your empty case back on the trailer. Please follow directions from the equipment crew.

6. If you have trouble with your uniform, need a safety pin, first aid, etc. please see Chris Metz or Heidi Travis. They will help you. I am very busy and can't answer small questions. Let them help you.
