PRAIRIE CENTRAL COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 8

The first day of school will be on Wednesday, August 20th. An abbreviated schedule will be followed that day, with dismissal at 1 PM. School will operate on a shortened day schedule (dismissal 1 hour early) from August 21st to August 29th. Buses and cafeterias will operate beginning August 20th. Beginning Sept. 2nd, the normal bell schedule will resume unless extreme heat causes the early dismissal schedule (1 hour early) to be extended. This decision will be made on a day-by-day basis and parents will be notified via announcements over the radio.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION - IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Students entering ECE, Pre-K, Kindergarten, Sixth Grade,(if a physical was performed at grade 5, which was the previous requirement, this will suffice for grade 6) and Ninth Grade are required to have a physical and updated immunization. The immunizations include the basic “baby shots” with boosters of DPT, Polio, and MMR after the age of 4. The Varicella vaccine is now required. If your child has had the Chicken Pox (Varicella) disease, we will require a note from your physician. For students entering fifth grade, immunizations would include the Hepatitis B vaccine (series of 3 shots) and for students entering ninth grade, immunizations would include Diphtheria and Tetanus (DPT) vaccine. All students entering K, 2nd, & 6th grade will also be required to have a dental exam completed. An exam after August 23, 2007 is acceptable if recorded on a dental examination form approved by the State of Illinois.

LEAD TESTING REQUIREMENT

Each child age six and younger must have a blood test for lead prior to being admitted to school.

NEW STUDENTS

New students to the school district should contact the school offices for information on physical examination and immunization requirements.

PRAIRIE CENTRAL JUNIOR HIGH

High School parents will be sent the registration materials after July 28th. These materials may be completed at home and returned at registration.

Alternative High School students and Special Education students attending outside of Prairie Central C.U.S.D. #8 are to register at their home school. For students attending Pontiac schools, fees will be paid later at Pontiac. For students attending LCSSU Academy, Bloomington, and Esmen, fees will be paid at the student's appropriate home school in the Prairie Central district.

LAVC students - Prairie Central students who will be attending the Livingston Area Vocational Center will be paying vocational class fees at the Prairie Central High School.

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
